introduction

At Grace Church, we are a community of believers, working together to fulfill our mission: to Love God, Love Others and Make Disciples! Each of our ministries is focused on this goal and requires dedicated individuals to succeed. Our staff and experienced volunteers help provide training and support in all areas for those willing to get involved. This booklet contains all the areas where you can get involved.

worship ministries

“Providing opportunities to worship God in Spirit and Truth, responding to His worth and glory.”

Worship Teams

Leads our congregation in song and praise in our Sunday morning services. Ways to serve include singing or playing an instrument.

Offertory

Provides background music during offering time.

Tech Team

Provides technical support in the sound booth for Sunday services. Also responsible for livestream. Ways to serve include working in the sound booth, operating the video cameras and operating the presentation computer.

Chapel Services

Provides services at Boundary Trails, Salem Home and Eden. Ways to serve include bringing a devotional, singing team and porter team.

witness ministries

“Sharing with others how Jesus has changed lives and given a hope and a future, both locally and globally.”

Missions Team

Responsible for approval for missionary funding (either individuals or organizations) and follow up. Ways to serve include being a member of the mission team and letter-writing.

Partnership Ministries

Responsible for updating the congregation regarding several organizations we financially support. Ways to serve include being a contact representative for Salem Home, Salem Auxiliary, The Bunker, MCC, MDS or Habitat for Humanity.

Sandwich Ministry

Volunteers make approximately 300 sandwiches weekly and deliver to UGM in Winnipeg to feed the homeless. Ways to serve include being part of the sandwich making and delivering to Winnipeg.

love ministries

“Focus on creating places of belonging and safety where people can learn to believe in Jesus, join others who are learning to behave like Him, and together become a living example of Him. The vision is for all people to know they are valued in this community of faith.”

Front Door Ministry

The goal is to offer a welcoming experience to Sunday services for newcomers and regular attenders. Ways to serve include being a greeter, an usher and tending the Welcome Desk.

Community Connections

These ministries focus on bringing opportunities to meet together and connect as a church family.

Sunday Morning Coffee Fellowship

Coffee and snacks are served in the fellowship hall for the hour before Sunday service. Ways to serve include preparing snacks and serving and cleaning Sunday mornings.

C3 Team (Covenant Community Connections)

Responsible to plan and organize events including Winter Fun Day, Summer Fun Day, Kick-Off, Movie Night, etc.

Women's & Men's Ministry

Plan Bible studies, retreats and social events.

Food Service Team

Works closely with the C3 Team and is responsible for planning and serving food for church events. Also organizes Mutual Munches (congregational lunch) throughout the year. Ways to serve include being part of the organization team and volunteering to serve and clean at events.

Shower Team

Responsible to organize showers for new brides and mothers (either in person or through newsletter). Ways to serve include connecting with bride/mom, purchasing gifts, planning the shower, etc.

Care & Connections

Lend assistance to our Care & Connection Pastor to care for our church community during times of crisis (death in the family, recovering from surgery and illness, etc.) Ways to serve include preparing meals, delivery of care package, calls of encouragement, etc.

Small Group Connections

These ministries focus on specific groups within our church community.

Senior Care

Responsible to match our seniors and shut-ins with a partner to connect with regularly. Ways to serve include volunteering as a partner.

Senior's Fellowship

Monthly supper for those 55+. Time of fellowship and entertainment. Ways to serve include helping prepare and organize events.

Small Groups/Care Groups

Care groups meet regularly for Bible study and fellowship. Some may be specific (new to Grace, college & career, young families, retirees, etc.) Others may be mixed groups. Ways to serve include starting and hosting a new group or joining an existing group.

Prayer Ministry

Ministry to provide prayer for those in need. Ways to serve include being part of our prayer chain. When prayer requests are received at the office, they are emailed out to the prayer chain. We would also like a prayer team available for prayer after Sunday services.

learn ministries

“Facilitate the process of acquiring new or modifying existing knowledge, behaviors, skills, values or preferences about God, life and relationships, for the purpose of equipping and supporting each other in service to God.”

Sunday School

Provides biblical teaching to children from the age of 3 through high school. There is also a class for adults. Ways to serve include volunteering as a Sunday School teacher, helper and working with the Sunday School administration.

Youth Ministry

Provides teaching, leadership and fellowship for students in grades 7-12. Ways to serve include being a small group leader, part of the worship team and administration.

Child Care

Ministry to provide a safe space for children aged 3-5 to play during the Sunday service. Ways to serve include being a care provider and organization of ministry.

Library Ministry

Provides a variety of materials accessible to the church community including biography, inspirational, devotional and fiction for adults and children. Ways to serve include supervising the library on Sunday mornings, restocking returned materials and purchase of new materials.

management ministries

“Establishing a unified collection of support ministries that enable Grace Church to fulfill its mission.”

Maintenance Crew

Provides support to maintenance manager. Tasks may include painting, building, yard and parking lot maintenance.

Landscaping Crew

Similar to maintenance crew but works specifically with the shrubs and plants around the church.
