

#### From the Lead Team

I went biking around Morden Lake with a friend today and we had such a great time! At one point I looked out over the lake and was reminded of how beautiful it is, and more importantly, how far we've come. When I first started riding on the lake trail (a few years ago), it was really hard, there were many up-hills on the trail I couldn't climb - either because I wasn't strong enough, or because I didn't have the right technique - and I would get off my bike and walk it to the top. Now I rarely need to get off my bike, usually I can make it to the top of the climbs and don't need to stop for breaks.

1 Sam 7:12 says "Samuel took a stone and set it up between Mizpah and Shen. He named it Ebenezer, saying, 'Thus far the LORD has helped us.'"

I think it's important to look back at how far God has brought us, to celebrate the victories over sin, God's faithfulness in times of trouble, and His provision in time of need.

Samuel set up an Ebenezer stone, a reminder of how God helped them.

I recently had coffee with a friend and he asked me to share some details of a situation I'd been in and how I'd seen God's provision. It had been a particularly difficult time, but as I shared story after story of how God provided for us, either through friends or family, or through believers who we didn't even know, I had to smile at God's goodness, and it was good to look back and reflect on His care.

I'd encourage you to take some time this week to

look back on God's faithfulness in your own life, and if you have opportunity, share it with someone, or ask how God has helped them thus far.















The library is open every Sunday from 10:15-10:45.
