Mission Focus



For the last 18 years, Grace Church has been making sandwiches each week and

taking them to Union Gospel Mission in Winnipeg. UGM uses these sandwiches to provide a quick response to those who show up at the door hungry, as well as giving them to those attending chapel and meal programs. The goal has been to provide a nice looking sandwich with at least 2g of protein with the hope that those receiving the sandwiches would know someone cares for them. Short Bible verses and/or picture stickers are added to the wrapping as a reminder to the recipient that they matter to God. We are grateful that John & Helen Friesen stepped in to take over sandwich prep this year.

In 2022 a 4kg chub of bologna cost \$31. This year we have paid as much as \$43 for the same amount. As the cost of making these sandwiches increases, we would like to give the Covenant Community an opportunity to provide funds for keeping this ministry going.
